Sir/Madam,

This is with reference to the proposal submitted by Shri Shamrao Patil (Yadravkar) Educational & Charitable Trust's Sharad Institute of Technology College of Engineering, Kolhapur-416 121, Maharashtra affiliated to Dr. Babaahab Ambedkar Technological University, Maharashtra under the UGC Scheme for Autonomous Colleges.

As per the decision of the Standing Committee constituted by University Grants Commission, in its meeting held on 16.12.2020, the Competent Authority has decided to grant autonomous status to **Shri Shamrao Patil (Yadravkar) Educational & Charitable Trust's Sharad Institute of Technology College of Engineering, Kolhapur-416 121, Maharashtra** affiliated to **Dr. Babaahab Ambedkar Technological University, Maharashtra** for a period of Ten (10) years from the session 2020-2021 to 2029-2030 as per provisions of Clause 3.13 and Clause 6.4 (i) of UGC Regulations dated 12.02.2018.

The University is requested to issue necessary notification/order regarding the grant of autonomous status to the college as per UGC (Conferment of Autonomous Status Upon Colleges and Measures for Maintenance of Standards in Autonomous Colleges) Regulations, 2018 for Autonomous Colleges. The college, if eligible, shall apply for autonomy grant as per the norms laid down in the Regulations.

The autonomous college is required to abide by all the provisions of the UGC Regulations for Autonomous Colleges. The Regulations are available on the UGC website, www.ugc.ac.in. Non compliance of the requirements and conditions in the said Regulations shall attract action as per Clause -14 of the UGC Regulations – 2018. The college shall also apply in the prescribed format to University Grants Commission for extension of autonomous status six months prior to the expiry of the autonomous cycle.
